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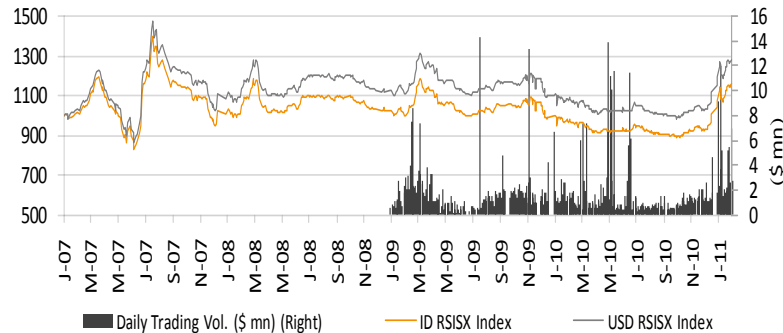

**News from Iraq**
**Politics**

- Iraqi Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki said on Saturday that he decided not to run for a third term in office, according to a semi-official news channel. (Aswat Al-Iraq)
- Iraqi Kurdistan Region Prime Minister Burham Saleh on Saturday discussed with Palestinian Foreign Minister Riad al-Malki in Arbil means to further bilateral relations and political developments in Iraq and the region, according to a media source in Saleh's office. (Aswat Al-Iraq)
- Iraqi President Jalal Talabani will pay a visit to Damascus next Saturday, a Syrian newspaper said on Saturday. (Aswat Al-Iraq)

**Economics**

- The current level of crude oil prices, now registering over \$100 per barrel, will bring about an increase in proceeds above what is expected in the federal state budget, according to the official spokesman for the oil ministry on Saturday. (Aswat Al-Iraq)
- Iraq will respect profit-sharing contracts signed by the Kurdistan region with foreign oil firms, ending a long-standing dispute between the two sides, Prime Minister Nuri al-Maliki told AFP Saturday. (Zawya)
- Salah al-Din's deputy governor laid the foundation stone for the largest housing compound in the city of Tikrit on Thursday at about \$238mn, to be set up by a Jordanian company, an official said. (Aswat Al-Iraq)
- The Wassit council signed on Thursday a deal with an Iranian company to establish a chloride factory, chairman of the council said. (Aswat Al-Iraq)

### Daily Transactions in Brief

The Iraq Stock Exchange held the third session of the month today. 48 companies were able to trade in this session, and 12 companies were unable to do so mainly due to their General Assembly Meeting or ISX / ISC Instructions. The number of traded shares was 2.1bln and the trading volume was ID3.2bln (\$2.8mn).

Foreigners executed 148 transactions in this session. They executed 145 buying transactions in 23 companies operating in banking, services, industry and hotel&tourism sectors, and three selling transactions in two companies operating in banking and industry sectors. Thus, net purchases of foreigners reached ID1.1bln (\$953k), while their share in total trading volume was 17.7%. According to trading volumes, the first three companies that were bought by foreigners were Al-Mansour Bank (BMNS), United Bank (BUND) and Ishtar Hotels (HISH), while the companies that were sold by foreigners were Al-Mansour Bank (BMNS) and Fallujah for Construction Materials (IFCM).
