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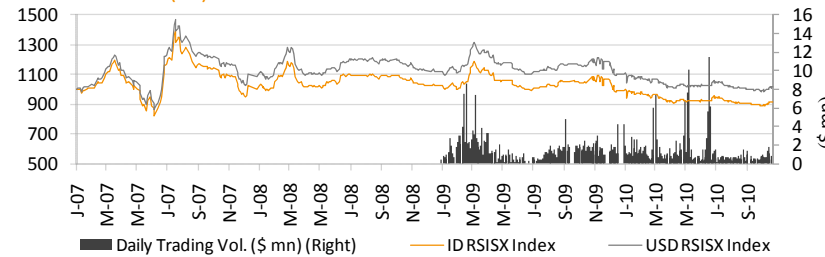

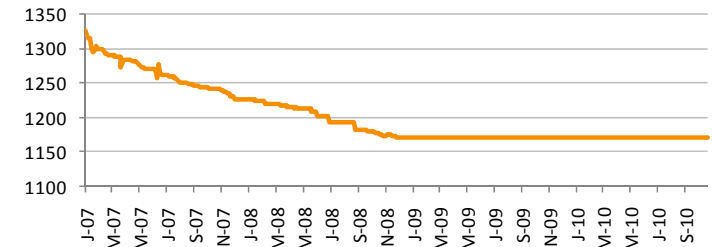

Rabee Securities (RS) Index - RSISX Index

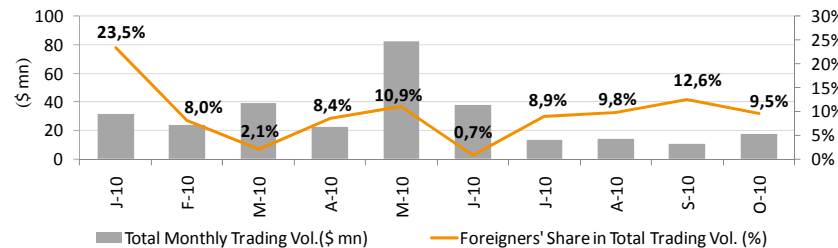


Iraqi Dinar Value

By the end of the week, 39 companies were able to trade in this session, and 27 companies were unable to do so mainly due to their General Assembly Meeting or ISX / ISC Instructions.

The dinar remained stable for the week, trading at 1170 to the dollar. Volumes for the week reached ID4.9 bln (\$4.2 mn), and the numbers of shares

traded reached 3.1 bln, with the banking sector experiencing the highest volume and turnover.

Foreigners executed total 282 transactions this week. They executed 269 buying transactions amounting at ID906mn (\$775ths) and 13 selling transactions amounting at ID81mn (\$69ths). Thus, net purchases of foreigners reached ID826mn (\$706ths), while their share in total trading volume was 9.5%.

News from Iraq

Politics

- U.S. ambassador in Baghdad said Wednesday that his country committed to a long-term partnership with Iraq in all fields.
- General Secretary of the Patriotic Union of Kurdistan (PUK), Jalal Talabani, reviewed with the party's leaders in Kirkuk the latest political developments, a media source said.
- Iraq's President Jalal Talabani and his Deputy, Adel Abdul-Mahdi, have reiterated necessity for the acceleration of forming the new government, according to a Presidency statement on Monday.
- North Iraq Kurdistan Region's Premier, Barham Saleh, has left Erbil heading for Morocco on Monday for an official visit, aimed at strengthening relations between the two sides, according to an official spokesman for the Kurdistan Region.
- Iraqi Interior Minister Jawad Al Boulani announced police forces readiness to take over security command in all Iraq provinces.

Economics

- The Director-General of Iraq's South Oil Company, Di'a Jaafar, announced on Saturday that SOC signed a contract with an Australian consortium to implement two oil projects in southern Iraq. SOC signed contracts with the Australia's Leighton Holdings Limited to implement two projects.
- Iraq has exported 900,000 barrels of oil for Jordan over the past three months, according to an agreement concluded between the two countries.
- Iraq will play an important role to secure the energy sources Japan needs to implement industrial and investment projects, oil minister said on Wednesday. This came during a meeting between Minister Hussein al-Shahrestani and a Japanese diplomat in Baghdad.
- Chairman of the Diwaniya council signed on Monday Memorandums of Understanding with a group of Italian companies to carry out service projects in the province, according to his media advisor.
- Iraq and Sri-Lanka have signed a bilateral economic agreement for cooperation in economic, trade, scientific and cultural fields, Director of Iraqi Trade Ministry's Media said on Sunday.

ISX – Recent Company Announcements

- Ahliya For Insurance (NAHF) will resume trading on Monday, November 1st, 2010 after completing the capital increase processes through 16% bonus issue which will increase paid-up capital from ID1.3bln to ID1.508bln.
- Modern Sewing (IMOS) announced that the GA will be held on October 30th, 2010 to discuss capital reduction from ID1.8 bln (\$1.5 mn) to ID1.0 bln (\$0.9 mn). ISX suspended trading of IMOS shares starting from October 24th, 2010 due to this meeting.
