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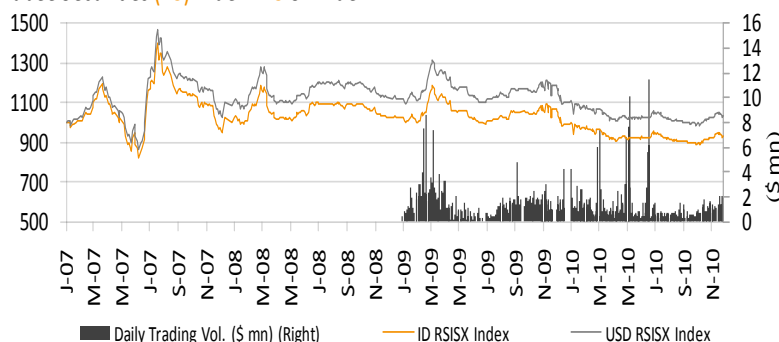

**News from Iraq**

**Politics**

- The Chairman of Iraq's Kurdistan Alliance, Fuad Maasoum, has expressed confidence that Iraq's Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki would be able to form the new government, within the defined constitutional period, as result of the current discussions among the leaders of the parliamentary blocs to distribute the cabinet posts and names of the proposed ministers.
- The Iraqi parliament adjourned its session until next Saturday (Dec. 4) to discuss its internal system, a lawmaker from the National Alliance said on Wednesday. The parliament had started its regular session today with the attendance of 225 members under the chairmanship of Osama al-Nujefi.
- The Special Representative of the UN Secretary-General for Iraq (SRSG), Ad Melkert, said on Wednesday that the UN mission works to improve relations between Iraq and Kuwait to bring the country out of Chapter VII.
- The ongoing U.S. military draw down in Iraq is making it more difficult for the United Nations to carry out its operations, which range from the humanitarian to the development to the political fields, UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon said in his latest report issued Wednesday.
- Italian President Giorgio Napolitano called on his Iraqi counterpart Jalal Talabani to foster relations between the two countries, according to a presidential statement.

**Economics**

- Iraq's cabinet on Wednesday approved a \$78.8bln budget for 2011 with a projected deficit of \$12.1bln, government spokesman Ali al-Dabbagh said.
- The corner stone for a ID350bln (around \$299mn) Shat al-Arab Canal project, aimed at pumping pure water for Basra Province and irrigation water for 250,000 donoms of agricultural lands, had been laid down by the Ministry of Water Resources on Thursday.

**Daily Transactions in Brief**

The Iraq Stock Exchange held the second session of the month today. 33 companies were able to trade in this session, and 25 companies were unable to do so mainly due to their General Assembly Meeting or ISX / ISC Instructions. The number of traded shares was 1.5bln and the trading volume was ID2.5bln (\$2.1mn).

Foreigners executed 55 transactions in this session. They executed 52 buying transactions in 13 companies operating in banking, services, industry and agriculture sectors, and three selling transactions in two companies operating in services and banking sectors. Thus, net purchases of foreigners reached ID83mn (\$71ths), while their share in total trading volume was 2.1%. According to trading volumes, the first three companies that were bought by foreigners were Gulf Commercial Bank (BGUC), Mamoura Realestate Investment (SMRI) and Credit Bank of Iraq (BROI), while the companies that were sold by foreigners were Mamoura Realestate Investment (SMRI) and Credit Bank of Iraq (BROI).
