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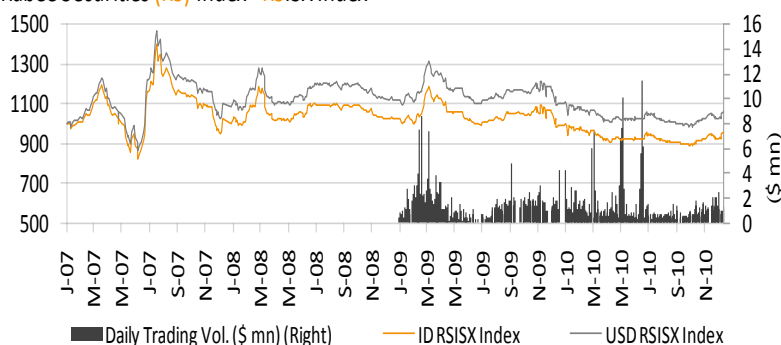

**News from Iraq**

**Politics**

- Al-Iraqiya Coalition, led by former Prime Minister Iyad Allawi, has nominated Falah al-Naqib for the Defense Minister's post and Maisoun al-Damalougi for the Culture Minister's post in the new Iraqi cabinet, scheduled to be announced by Prime Minister Designate, Nouri al-Maliki on Monday, al-Iraqiya's Legislature, Intisar Allawi, said on Sunday. (Aswat al-Iraq)
- Al-Iraqiya Coalition, led by former Prime Minister Iyad Allawi, has decided to present its candidates for the new cabinet later on Sunday, to include 11 ministers, according to its spokesman, Shaker Kattab. (Aswat al-Iraq)
- Iraq's Prime Minister Designate, Nouri al-Maliki, the Chairman of al-Iraqiya Coalition, Iyad Allawi and the Chairman of National Reform Trend, Ibrahim al-Jaafari, have discussed in Baghdad on Saturday night, necessity to accelerate the formation of the new government, reiterating its support through boosting trust among different political components, according to a statement by Jaafari's office on Sunday. (Aswat al-Iraq)
- Iraq's Prime Minister designate, Nouri al-Maliki, has presented an official demand to the Parliament to form his new government on Monday, according to the State Ministry for Parliament Affairs on Saturday. (Aswat al-Iraq)
- Several members of al-Iraqiya Coalition has described the Parliament's decision to lift "eradication" decisions against three of their Coalition members, as "the first step in the way of national reconciliation." (Aswat al-Iraq)
- Iraq shall strive to develop nuclear energy for peaceful purposes, following the issuance of the UN Security Council resolution to lift the sanctions against Iraq in this respect, the Undersecretary of the Iraqi Oil Ministry, Assem Jihad, said on Saturday. (Aswat al-Iraq)

- The Iraqi cabinet forwarded to parliament the 2011 draft state budget, which hit nearly ID78trln (roughly \$67bln), according to a lawmaker from Al-Iraqiya bloc on Saturday. (Aswat al-Iraq)

**Daily Transactions in Brief**

The Iraq Stock Exchange held the eleventh session of the month today. 46 companies were able to trade in this session, and 23 companies were unable to do so mainly due to their General Assembly Meeting or ISX / ISC Instructions. The number of traded shares was 1.0bln and the trading volume was ID1.5bln (\$1.3mn).

Foreigners executed 95 buying transactions in 26 companies operating in banking, insurance, investment, services, hotel&tourism and industry sectors, while their purchases amounted at ID378mn (\$323ths) and their share in total trading volume was 12.3%. According to trading volumes, the first three companies that were bought by foreigners were Bank of Baghdad (BBOB), Dar Es Salaam Investment Bank (BDSI) and Al- Mansour Hotel (HMAN).

Note: ISX will be closed during December 24th, 2010 - January 3rd, 2011 due to the end-of-year closing operations. The last session of this year will be on Thursday, December 23rd, 2010 and trading will resume on Tuesday January 4th, 2011.
