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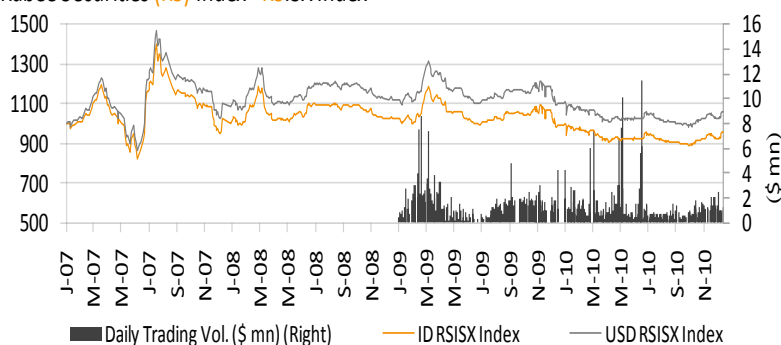

#### News from Iraq

##### Politics

- Sunday's session of the Iraqi Parliament had been adjourned to convene on Monday, to discuss the issue of forming the new government, according to a request by Prime Minister Designate, Nouri al-Maliki," according to a source in the Parliament's media office on Sunday. (Aswat Al-Iraq)
- Al-Iraqiya Coalition, led by former Prime Minister Iyad Allawi, has decided to present its candidates for the new cabinet later on Sunday, to include 11 ministers, according to its spokesman, Shaker Kattab. (Aswat Al-Iraq)
- The Candidate of Iraq's Turkomen Bloc for the Vice-President's post, Mohammed Mahdi al-Bayati, has called on other political blocs to support the demands of Turkomen to grant them a leading post in the new Iraqi government. (Aswat Al-Iraq)

##### Economics

- The central bank adviser said the appearance of Mohammed that the Iraqi economy liberated completely from all international restrictions, which put it 20 years ago, because of the policies of the dictatorial regime, pointing out that Iraq has emerged from Chapter VII, and the issue of Kuwaiti reparations does not affect the economic reality of Iraq. - Negotiations between the Iraqi Oil Ministry and the local government in West Iraq's Anbar Province, regarding the contracts to develop the gas fields in the province, has achieved a "major progress," according to a leading Oil Ministry spokesman on Sunday. (Aswat Al-Iraq)
- Southern Iraq's Grand Faw Terminal's project, recently approved by the Council of Ministers, shall provide employment opportunities for 150,000, according to a legislature of the National Coalition on Sunday. (Aswat Al-Iraq)

##### ISX – Recent Company Announcements

- Baghdad Soft Drinks (IBSD) will resume trading on December 23rd, 2010 after completing to increase its paid-in capital from ID105bln (\$90mn) to ID125bln (\$107mn) through 14% rights issue and 5% bonus issue. IBSD shares were not trading due the GA and capital increase process since June 11th, 2010

### Daily Transactions in Brief

The Iraq Stock Exchange held the twelfth session of the month today. 43 companies were able to trade in this session, and 23 companies were unable to do so mainly due to their General Assembly Meeting or ISX / ISC Instructions. The number of traded shares was 749mn and the trading volume was ID1.2bln (\$1.1mn).

Foreigners executed 58 buying transactions in 14 companies operating in banking, insurance, investment, services, hotel&tourism and industry sectors, while their purchases amounted at ID236mn (\$202ths) and their share in total trading volume was 9.5%. According to trading volumes, the first three companies that were bought by foreigners were Bank of Baghdad (BBOB), Palestine Hotel (HPAL) and Dar Al-Salam for Insurance (NDSA).

Note: ISX will be closed during December 24th, 2010 - January 3rd, 2011 due to the end-of-year closing operations. The last session of this year will be on Thursday, December 23rd, 2010 and trading will resume on Tuesday January 4th, 2011.
