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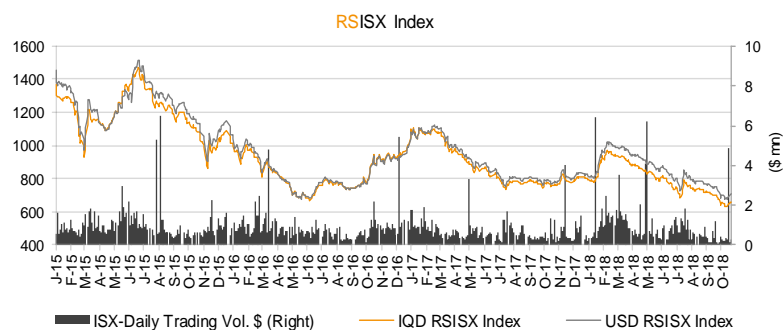

**News from Iraq**

**Politics**

- The Kurdistan Region's Judicial Council on Tuesday approved the results of the Sept. 30 parliamentary election, paving the way for newly-elected lawmakers to hold their first session. On Oct. 20, the Kurdistan Region's Independent High Election and Referendum Commission (IHERC) announced the final result of the vote. According to the result, the Kurdistan Democratic Party (KDP), which led the 2017 independence referendum, won the election with a significant margin, gaining 688,070 votes. The party secured 45 seats in the Region's 111-seat parliament. (Kurdistan 24)
- Delegates from the ruling Kurdistan Democratic Party (KDP) met with a number of Russian officials on Tuesday for talks on the bilateral ties between the sides. The KDP delegation also met with members of the United Russia Party, led by President Vladimir Putin, in which they focused on the latest political developments in the Kurdistan Region and further support for the region. (Bas News)
- President of the New Generation Movement Shaswar Abdulwahid met with a number of officials at the US State Department in Washington, DC on Tuesday. The two sides discussed the new Iraqi cabinet, the relations between the Kurdistan Region and Baghdad, as well as New Generation's strategy for Iraq and the Region. (NRT tv)

**Economics**

- The oil ministry aims to increase Iraq's oil output capacity and will support foreign oil companies in their work, the new oil minister Thamer al-Ghadbhan said on Wednesday. He also told a news conference that the ministry would seek to develop oil refineries and increase their production capacity. (Zawya)
- The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) announced Monday signed an agreement with the government of South Korea that would see \$5 mn allocated to support stabilization and recovery operations in parts of Iraq formerly held by ISIS. (NRT tv)
- Iraq and Iran signed an agreement to increase flights between the two countries from 91 to 120 trips annually. According to Iranian aviation public relations, both sides agreed for mutual cooperation and training. (Iraq Trade Link)

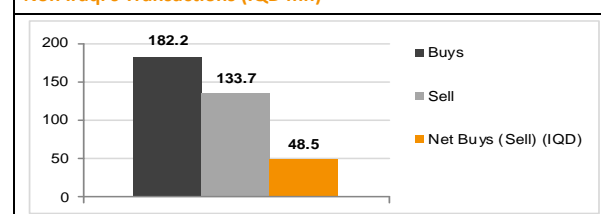

We adjusted unaudited profit before tax values by deducting 15% income tax, while calculating annualized YTD profit.

P/BV (Last): Calculated by dividing "Current Mcap" to "BV in its Last Financials".

Iraqi banks started to publish IFRS annual reports starting 2016; however, interim period results are available according to Iraqi accounting rules. As a result, we will continue to depend only on the financial results prepared according to Iraqi accounting rules to be able to work with consistent data till the financial statements for both quarterly and annual data will be available according to IFRS standards.
