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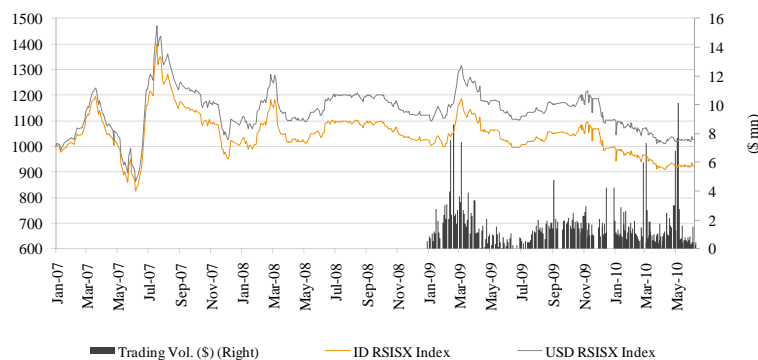

**News From Iraq**

**Politics**

- Iraqi Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki received on Wednesday a letter from his British counterpart David Cameron, in which he underlined Britain's commitment to strengthen security and stability in Iraq, according to a cabinet's statement.
- President of Iraq's Kurdistan region, Massoud Barzani, signed on Wednesday a Memorandum of Understanding with the French government to develop cooperation in cultural, scientific, and technical fields, said the statement received by Aswat al-Iraq news agency.
- Prime Minister of Iraq's Kurdistan region, Barham Saleh, stressed on Wednesday on the importance of boosting relations with Britain, a media source of the Kurdistan's delegation said.

**Economics**

- Iraqi Council on Ministers has decided to approve an agreement that settles down Madagascar's debt to Iraq. "80% of the debt (i.e. \$234.5 mn) has been cancelled," the Iraqi government said in a release on Wednesday as received by Aswat al-Iraq news agency. The 20% left will be paid on dispatches.
- The Director General of the Ministry of Foreign Trade Abdullah Ahmed Al Saleh has affirmed that the United Arab Emirates is interested in boosting its commercial and investment ties with Iraq, including the Kurdistan Region.
- The Iraqi Water Resources Ministry on Tuesday began work to execute a water management project in Karbala province. It said that the project is funded by Iraq with ID5 bln (\$4.3 mn), but executed in coordination with the Japanese International Cooperation Agency (JICA).
- The second bridge was opened in Karbala on Thursday at a cost of ID10 bln (\$8.5 mn), according to the governor's media spokesman.
- Wasset's share from al-Ahdab oilfield's revenues reached \$212 ths for only two months, deputy governor said on Thursday.

### Daily Transactions in Brief

The Iraq Stock Exchange held the thirteenth session of the month today. 27 companies were able to trade in this session, and 20 companies were unable to do so mainly due to their General Assembly Meeting. The number of traded shares was 1.9 bln and the trading volume was ID3.2bln (\$2.8 mn).

Foreigners executed 32 buying transactions in 10 companies operating in banking and industry sectors. The total number shares traded by foreigners was 74.5 mn, and the total trading volume was ID113.2 mn (\$96.8 ths). According to trading volumes, the first three companies that were bought by foreigners were United Bank (BUND), Mosul Bank (BMFI) and Al-Mansour Bank (BMNS).
