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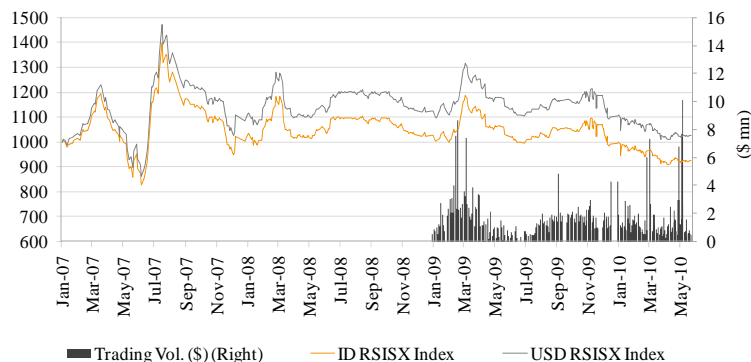

**News From Iraq**

**Politics**

- The Sadrists, or Iraqis loyal to Shiite leader Muqtada al-Sadr, would never allow the return of dictatorship and autocracy in Iraq, a Sadrist spokesman said on Saturday.
- Iraqi Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki arrived in Najaf on Saturday to meet with the highest Shiite clergy represented by Grand Ayatollah Sayyid Ali al-Sistani.

**Economics**

- The Director of the Iraqi Stock Exchange (ISX), Taha Ahmed Abdulsalam, said on Saturday that the ISX will launch a new general indicator after the increase of the appointed companies, and also start a new system for the shareholders by next June.
- Iraqi Kurdistan could raise oil production to 200,000 barrels per day by the end of 2010 and hopes to resume crude exports, the autonomous region's energy minister was quoted as saying Friday.
- A conference has been held on Saturday in Basra to discuss methods to invest the province's revenues.
- Head of the Diwaniya Investment Commission said on Friday that a Memorandum of Understanding has been signed with an Italian group to establish a residential compound in the province.
- The trade ministry said on Saturday that it has finished preparations to set up a metal silo in northern Thi-Qar with a capacity of 30,000 tons and a cost of ID8.260 bln (roughly \$7 mn) to enhance the province's storage capacity, according to the director of the general company for grains.
- China's top power equipment maker Shanghai Electric is moving ahead with a \$1 billion power-generating plant to boost Iraq's electricity capacity by 1,320 MW, officials said on Saturday.
- The Lebanese Club in Baghdad is the start off of governmental endeavors aimed to establish family clubs in the capital.

**Daily Transactions in Brief**

The Iraq Stock Exchange held the twentyfirst session of the month today. 33 companies were able to trade in this session, and 14 companies were unable to do so mainly due to their General Assembly Meeting. The number of traded shares was 304.7 mn and the trading volume was ID494.5 mn (\$422.6 ths).

Foreigners executed seven buying transactions in four companies operating in banking, services and industry sectors. The total number shares traded by foreigners was 3.7 mn, and the total trading volume was ID4.5 mn (\$3.9 ths). According to trading volumes, the first three companies that were bought by foreigners were Baghdad Soft Drinks (IBSD), Dijlah & Furat Bank (BDFD) and North Bank (BNOR).
